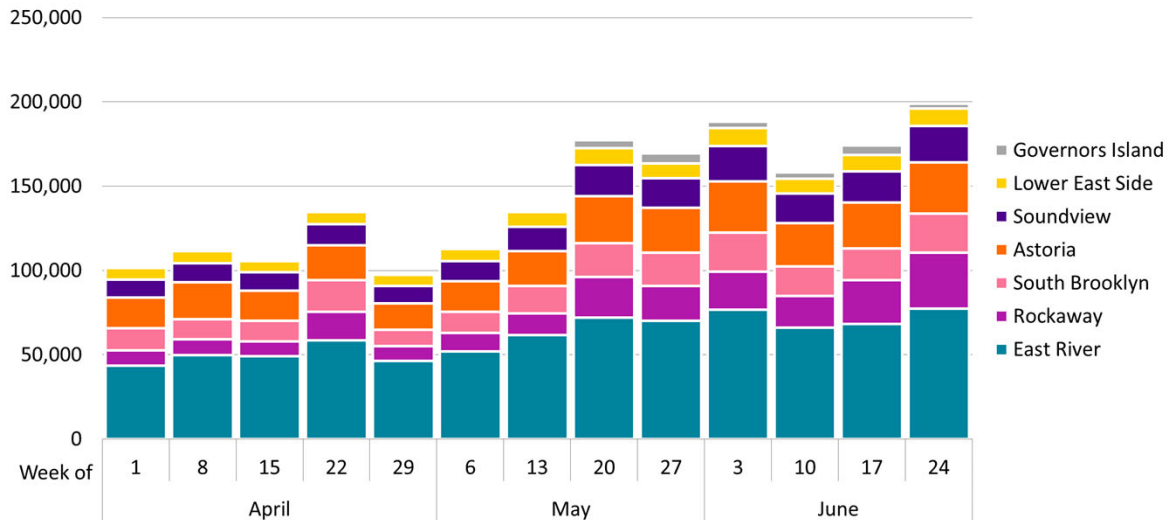

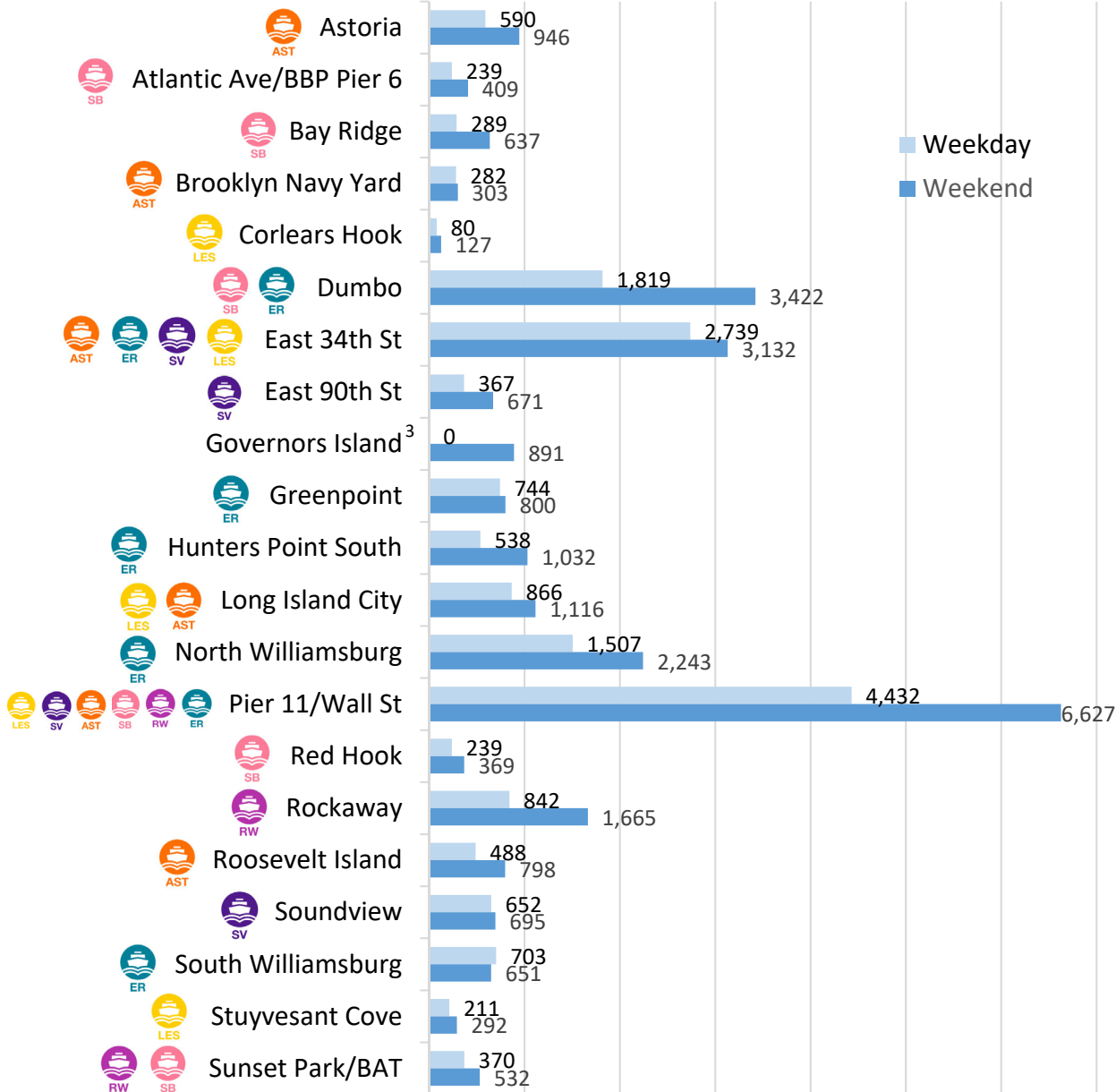


RIDERSHIP BY LANDING

Highlights

The Brooklyn Navy Yard stop opened on May 20th as part of the Astoria route. This landing marks NYC Ferry's first stop at a dedicated jobs center and has improved connectivity to growing neighborhoods nearby. Three more 350-passenger vessels were delivered and put into service.



Service Notes

Due to significant flooding at the Greenpoint ferry landing as a result of severe rain, service to Greenpoint was temporarily suspended in late May for several hours. Free shuttle buses were provided for riders and crews on-site found safe solutions to alleviate flooding while keeping the landing open despite heavy rain fall.

¹On Time Performance is calculated as the percentage of stops made within the quarter that depart no more than 1 minute before and arrive no more than 5 minutes past their scheduled times. This report includes delays due to events outside of the control of NYC Ferry, such as vessel traffic, river closures/obstructions, extreme weather conditions, and other U.S. Coast Guard restrictions. When tracking devices are offline, the stops are excluded from the calculation. ²Number of NYCF-branded vessels available for use; NYCF Partners with other operators to charter vessels at times of high demand. ³NYCF operates to Governors Island on weekends during its public season. Figure includes average ridership on weekends when service operated in Q2. ⁴Governors Island ridership is included in this figure.
