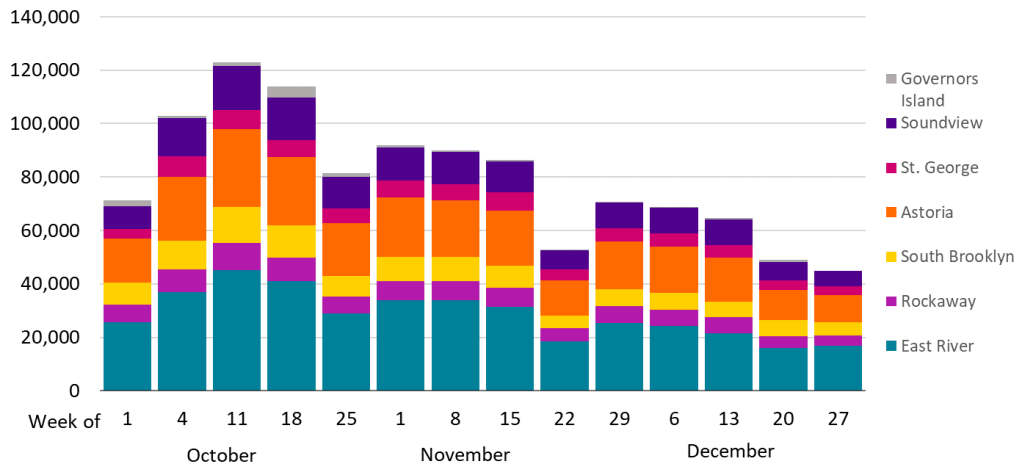

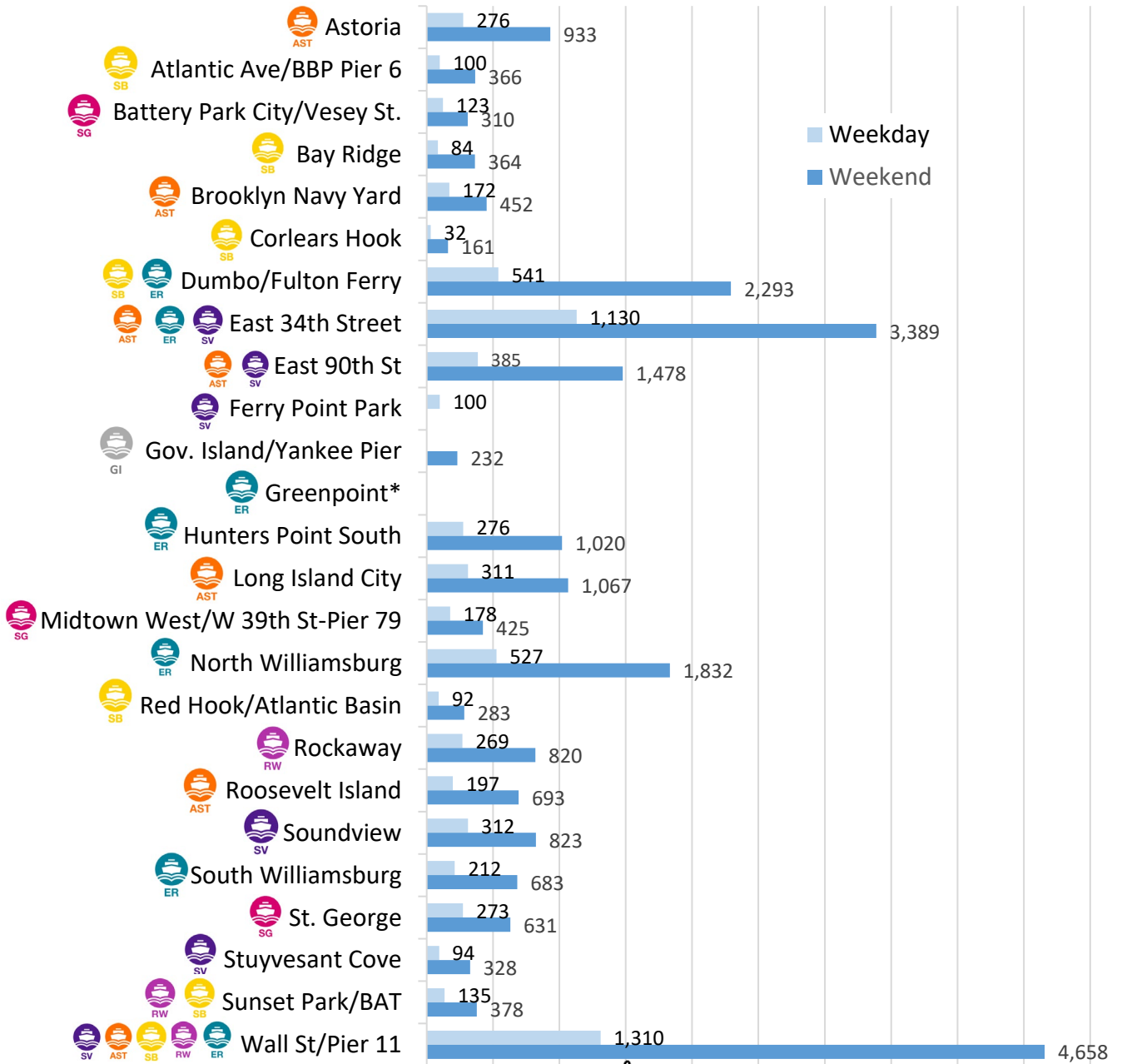

Highlights

Service Notes

NYC Ferry continued to see ridership recovery into the winter. The Astoria route had its best-ever calendar year ridership (1.1 million), and some weeks saw ridership greater than its pre-pandemic equivalent week. The Throgs Neck landing at Ferry Point Park was added to the Soundview route on December 28, 2021.

The Greenpoint landing remained closed in Q4. Winter schedule began operating on November 22 and the Governors Island weekend shuttle continued operating due to Governors Island’s announcement of year-round programming.

¹On Time Performance is calculated as the percentage of trips that departed no more than 1 minute before and arrive no more than 5 minutes past their scheduled times at each landing. This report does not include delays due to events outside of the control of NYC Ferry, such as vessel traffic, river closures/obstructions, extreme weather conditions, and other U.S. Coast Guard restrictions. When tracking devices are offline, the stops are excluded from the calculation. ²Number of NYCF-branded vessels available for use.
