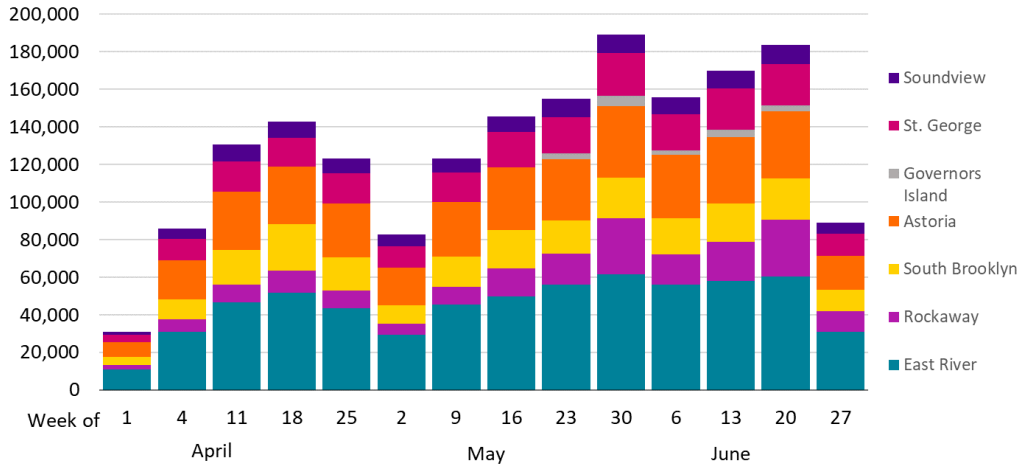

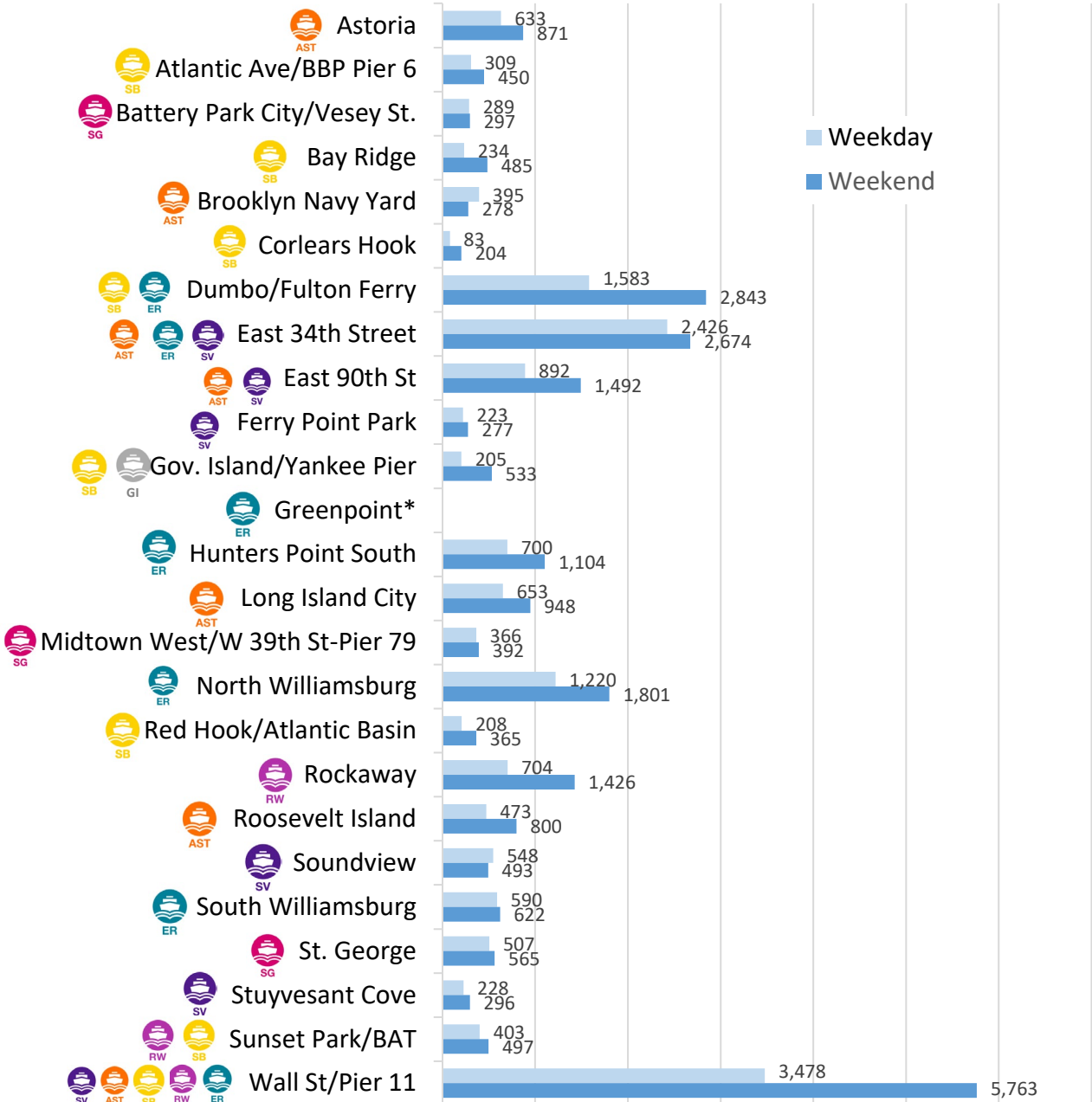

🔔 Service Notes

NYC Ferry ridership continued recovering in Q2, with April 2022 ridership exceeding April 2019. At the end of Q2, ridership in 2022 was approximately the same as 2019.

The Greenpoint landing remained closed in Q2. The Spring schedule began 4/4/2022, and the summer schedule began 5/23/2022. Governors Island-P11 shuttle resumed on 5/28/2022 as part of the summer schedule change.

<sup>1</sup>On Time Performance is calculated as the percentage of trips that departed no more than 1 minute before and arrive no more than 5 minutes past their scheduled times at each landing. This report does not include delays due to events outside of the control of NYC Ferry, such as vessel traffic, river closures/obstructions, extreme weather conditions, and other U.S. Coast Guard restrictions. When tracking devices are offline, the stops are excluded from the calculation. <sup>2</sup>Number of NYCF-branded vessels available for use.
