



Highlights

NYC Ferry carried over 1M riders in Q1 2024. A new March ridership record was set with over 450,000 riders in March 2024.



Service Notes

NYC Ferry ran a modified holiday schedule on New Years Day. A weekend schedule operated on MLK Jr. Day and Presidents Day. Gov. Island/Yankee Pier was out of service for planned maintenance until 3/30/2024.

¹On Time Performance is calculated as the percentage of stops that departed no more than 1 minute before and arrive no more than 5 minutes after their scheduled time. The calculation method for On Time Performance was updated for the 2023 Operating Agreement signed between the New York City Economic Development Corporation and Hornblower. This report does not include stops that were not recorded due to a connectivity issue or were delayed due to extreme weather/tidal conditions or U.S. Coast Guard restrictions.
