



NYC Ferry brought back its Rockaway Reserve service on Memorial Day, selling over 13,000 tickets in Q3. Over 900,000 riders boarded NYC Ferry in June, setting a new June ridership record.

NYC Ferry ran a modified holiday schedule on Juneteenth. During Memorial Day Weekend, additional frequency was added to the Rockaway Route.

¹On Time Performance is calculated as the percentage of stops that departed no more than 1 minute before and arrive no more than 5 minutes after their scheduled time. The calculation method for On Time Performance was updated for the 2023 Operating Agreement signed between the New York City Economic Development Corporation and Hornblower.
