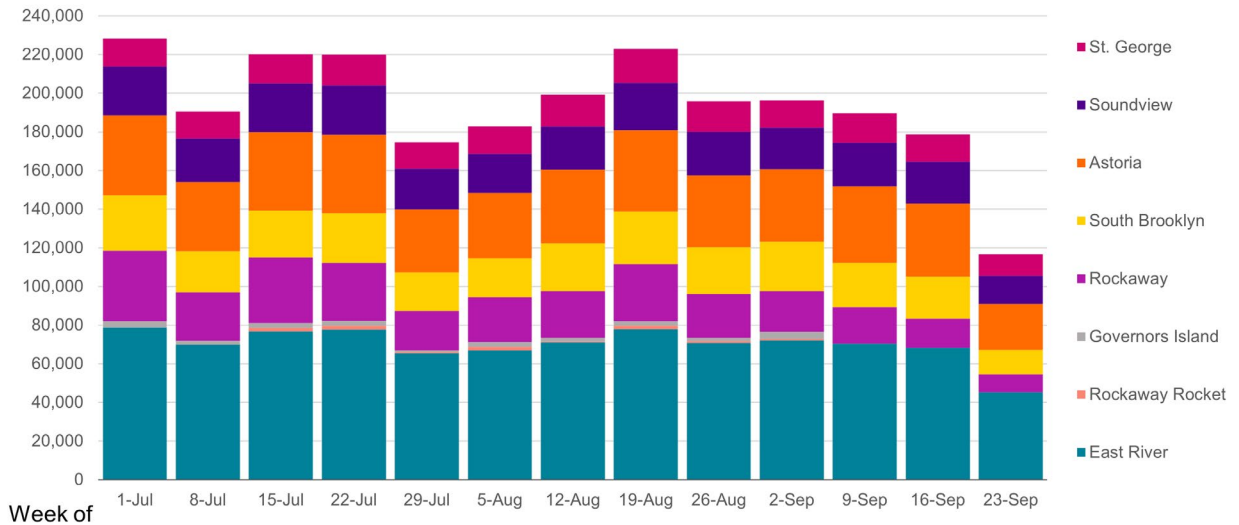

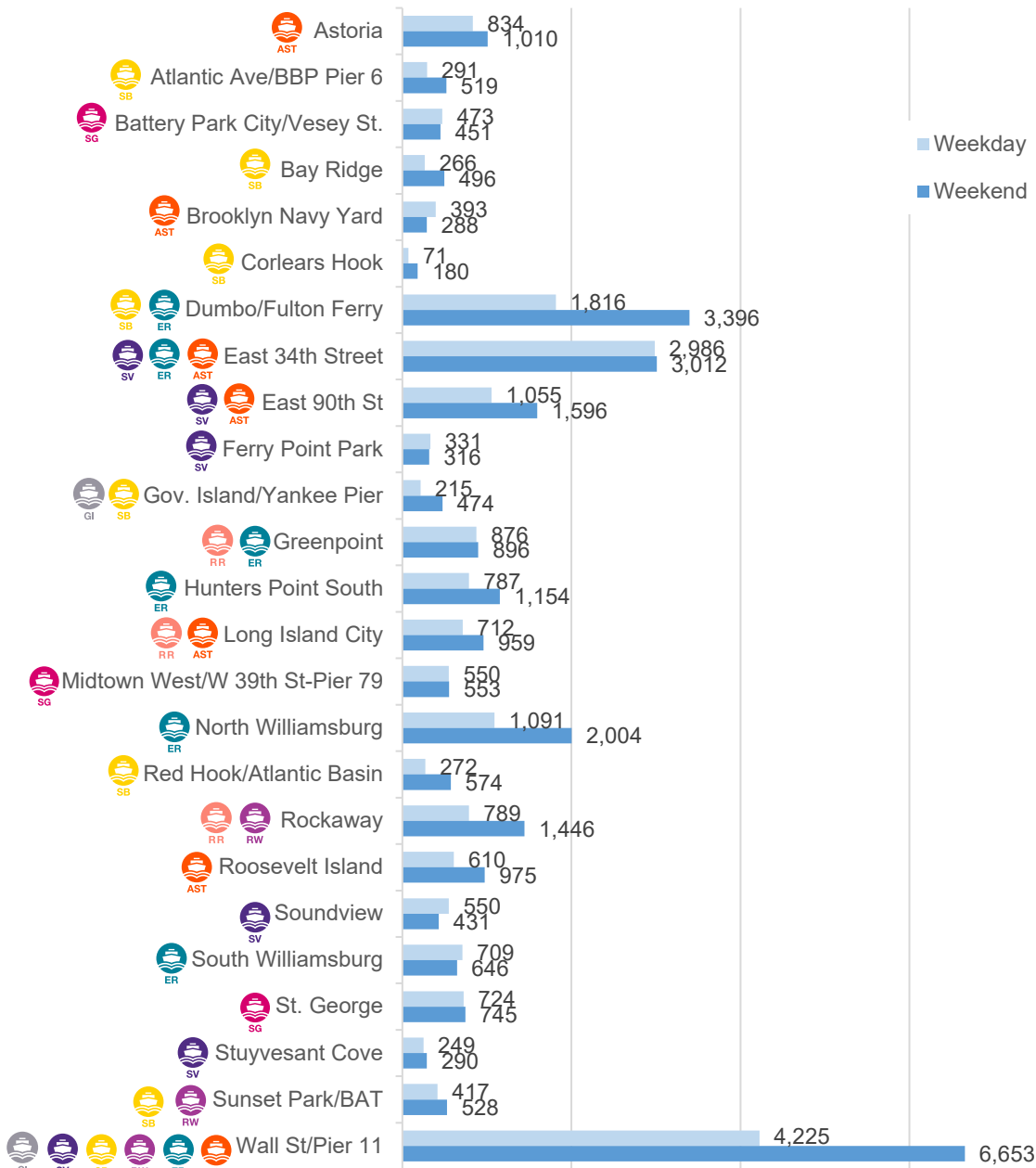

Highlights

The Rockaway Rocket launched on 7/20/2025, providing peak summer beach service to Long Island City and Greenpoint on summer weekends. This service sold over 10,000 tickets over 15 weekend days.



Service Notes

NYC Ferry added a vessel to Rockaway weekend service to provide 30-minute headways through 9/8. Security zones for the UN General Assembly caused service disruptions on 9/23, 9/24 and 9/25.

¹On Time Performance is calculated as the percentage of stops that departed no more than 1 minute before and arrive no more than 5 minutes after their scheduled time. The calculation method for On Time Performance was updated for the 2023 Operating Agreement signed between the New York City Economic Development Corporation and Hornblower. This report does not include stops that were not recorded due to a connectivity issue or were delayed due to extreme weather/tidal conditions or U.S. Coast Guard restrictions.
