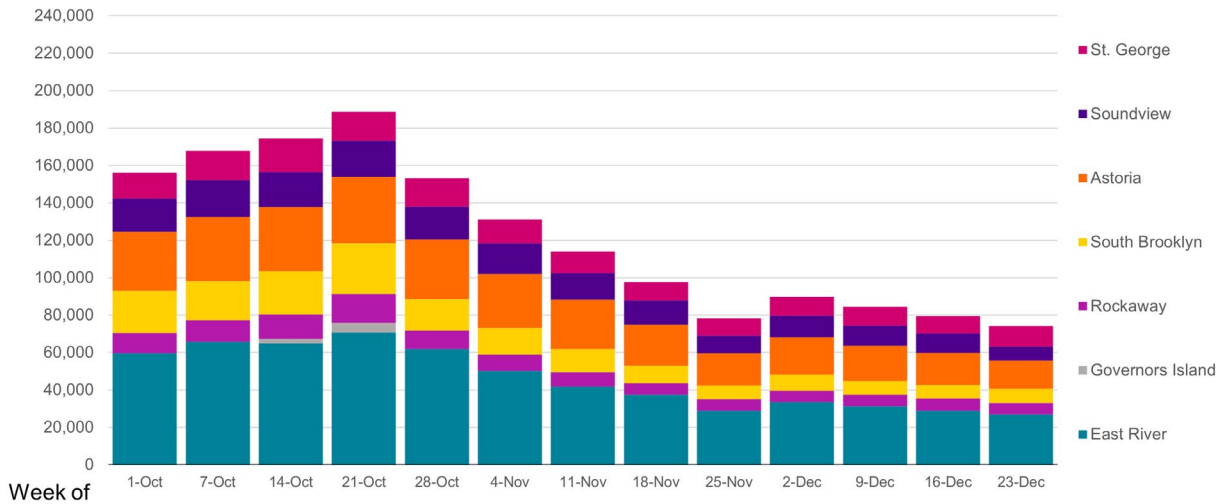

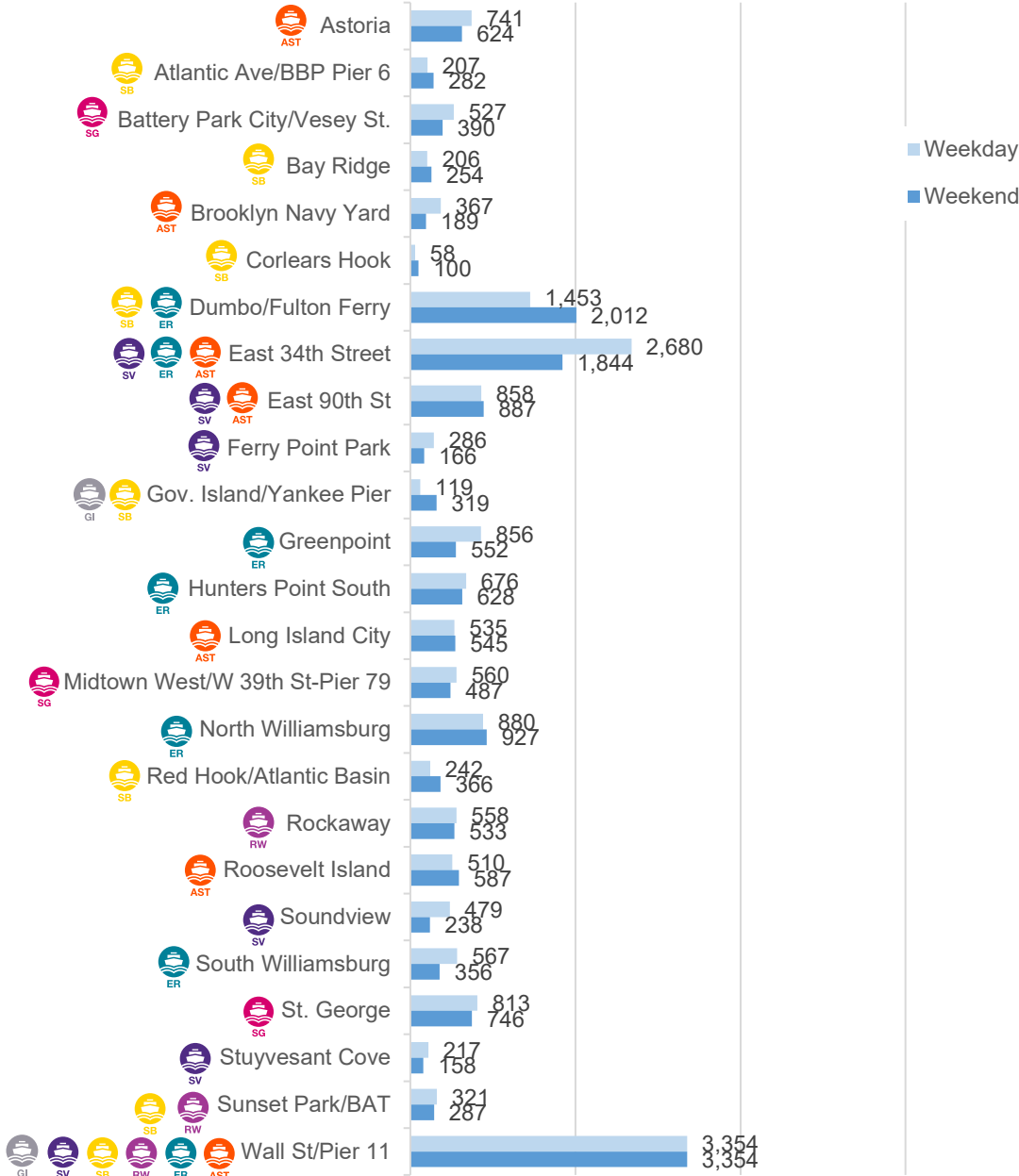

Highlights

Ridership was up on every route compared to Q4 2023, with a record-breaking October leading the way with over 700,000 riders. Weekend ridership was up 26% in Q4 of 2023, while weekday ridership was up 7%.



Service Notes

NYC Ferry operated a Modified Holiday Schedule for the Sukkot holiday from 10/20-10/23. NYC Ferry operated modified holiday schedules on 11/28 and 12/25.

¹On Time Performance is calculated as the percentage of stops that departed no more than 1 minute before and arrive no more than 5 minutes after their scheduled time. The calculation method for On Time Performance was updated for the 2023 Operating Agreement signed between the New York City Economic Development Corporation and Hornblower. This report does not include stops that were not recorded due to a connectivity issue or were delayed due to extreme weather/tidal conditions or U.S. Coast Guard restrictions.
