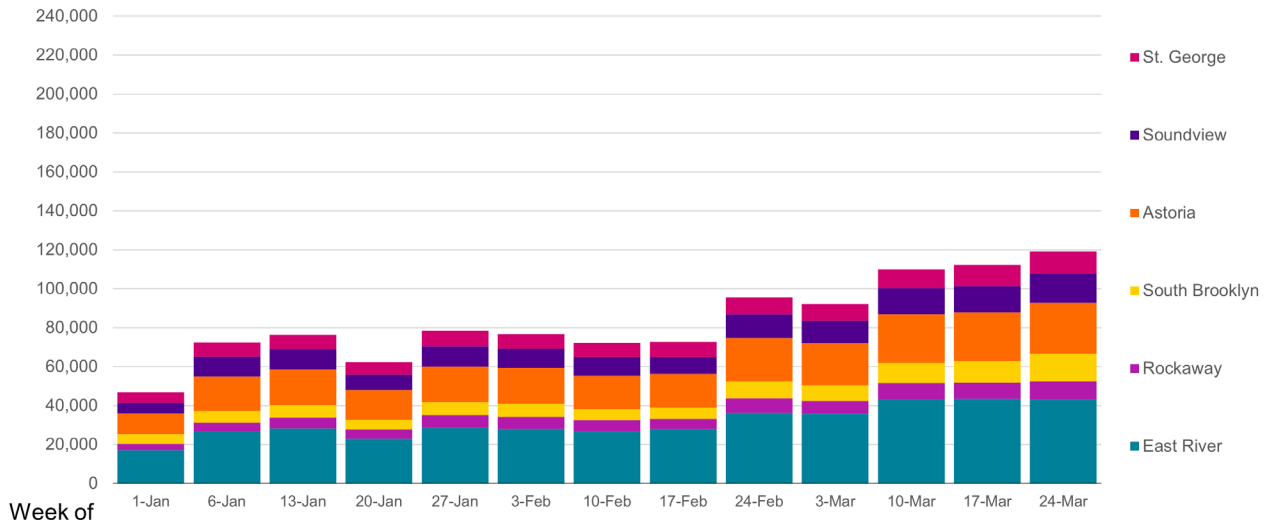

Highlights

Ridership grew 2% compared to Q1 in 2024, as average weekday ridership increased by 6% and average weekend ridership decreased by 4%. Colder, harsher weather conditions mostly contributed to the drop in weekend ridership.



Service Notes

NYC Ferry operated a Modified Holiday Schedule on 1/1. On 1/20 and 2/17, NYC Ferry operated a weekend schedule. NYC Ferry's spring schedule began on 3/31.

¹On Time Performance is calculated as the percentage of stops that departed no more than 1 minute before and arrive no more than 5 minutes after their scheduled time. The calculation method for On Time Performance was updated for the 2023 Operating Agreement signed between the New York City Economic Development Corporation and Hornblower. This report does not include stops that were not recorded due to a connectivity issue or were delayed due to extreme weather/tidal conditions or U.S. Coast Guard restrictions.
